2021 GCSE Post-Results Service

Dear Parent/Carer,

As we approach the end of this academic year, I am contacting you with further information regarding the Centre Determined Grade (CDG) Process.

Over the past few weeks the College has hosted virtual presentations on the CDG Process. The information shared included an overview of the CDG Policy, with details provided on the evidence to be used to inform the CDGs, access arrangements & guidance on how and when special consideration could be applied. In addition, the students were informed of the outcomes of their most recent assessments.

GCSE results on Thursday 12th August. Mr Toner will communicate about how your son can access his results and when they can be collected from the College at that time. This follow up letter will be issued next week.

The Post-Results Service is the final stage of the CDG process. This stage provides an opportunity for students to request a review of the CDG awarded in August 2021.
