**PUPIL CODE OF CONDUCT
FOR LIVE-STREAMED LESSONS**

When participating in a live-streamed lesson, pupils are reminded that these lessons are an extension of the classroom. The usual expectations regarding behaviour and participation in class remain unchanged and normal school rules apply in a live-streamed lesson. To ensure safe and effective live-streamed lessons, all pupils must also adhere to the following:

- Pupils must only engage in online video conferencing using Google Meet or Collaborate. They should use their c2k account to access lessons online and will be removed from the class if they are using another account.
- Pupils need to be appropriately dressed and should not wear pyjamas/sleep wear during the session.
- Pupils should be located in a quiet, safe space that is suitable for learning. They should be seated at a table/desk. The use of a bedroom should be avoided and pupils must be aware of the background that is visible on the screen.
- Pupils should promptly log in to sessions 5 minutes BEFORE the session begins.
- This will be a whole class activity and will not involve one-to-one contact with pupils.
- Pupils must follow the expected behaviour code during online lessons such as taking turns to speak and not interrupting teachers or other pupils.
- Pupils should remain attentive during the lesson and should not use any other electronic devices while the lesson takes place.
- The technology being used will allow teachers to mute their microphones and those of pupil participants or to remove pupils from the session.
- Pupils must not share any passwords or Meet links, that have been shared with them by the teacher, with anyone else.
- Pupils must not record sessions or capture screengrabs of teachers or pupils. Content or images from the lesson must not appear on social media or be shared with other pupils.
